

Uses of the Article

Post-reading, The Road to Corinth and the Agora (Paus. 2.2.2-8)

Read "The Definite Article" (*Grammar* 122-26). Then read each sentence below, identifying how the article is being used, i.e., with adjectives or adjectival phrase, participles, adverbs or adverbial phrases, as a change of subject, or with an infinitive.

Σίσυφος ἐτάφη ἐν τῷ ἰσθμῷ, ἀλλὰ ὀλίγοι τῶν ἐφ' αὐτοῦ Κορινθίων τὸν οἱ τάφον ἴσασι (3rd pl. of οἶδα).

λόγου δὲ ἄξια ἐν τῇ πόλει τὰ μὲν λειπόμενα ἔτι τῶν ἀρχαίων ἐστίν, τὰ δὲ πολλὰ αὐτῶν ἐπὶ τῆς ἀκμῆς ἐποιήθη τῆς ὕστερον.
